

EMERGENCY CARE FIRST RESPONDER

Including Advanced Resuscitation

The course is especially suited for first responders, mine rescue, firefighters, road rescue, security personnel and those tasked with managing a casualty in a remote area when medical assistance is not directly available.

Entry Requirements: HLTAID003 Provide first aid.

USI: A Unique Student Identifier (USI) number is required for all accredited training in Australia. If you do not provide a USI number the RTO, First Response Australia, may not be able to issue a Statement of Attainment upon successful completion of training.

Competencies Gained:

- HLTAID003 Provide first aid;
- HLTAID005 Provide first aid in remote situations;
- HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid;
- HLTAID007 Provide advanced resuscitation;
- PUAEME005A Provide pain management;
- EMRPHC412 Utilise intrathoracic pressure regulation technology within emergency medical care;
- EMRPHC410 Implement the universal triage system for pre-hospital care (**OPTIONAL**).

Course Duration: 5 Days (face to face) plus approx. 10 hours of pre-course study.

Assessment will include: Written/oral questions, practical assessments and scenario-based assessments.

Reasonable Adjustment: Highpoint supports learners with recognised disabilities and makes adjustments, where possible, according to each individual's needs. The level of adjustment required is determined on a case by case basis between Highpoint and the learner with a disability. Highpoint ensures any reasonable adjustment does not compromise the integrity of the competency standards.

Certification: Upon successful completion of the program your hardcopy Statement of Attainment will be posted to you within 30 calendar days (subject to all fees having been paid).

Course Physicality: A level of fitness and stamina is required to complete the practical assessment by spending extended periods of time on your knees at floor level.

Course Content:

- Primary Assessments (Basic Life Support/ Resuscitation);
- Secondary Assessment, Examination and Documentation;
- Advanced Resuscitation (Hypoxia, Bag Valve Mask Resuscitation, Manually Triggered Ventilators,

Oropharyngeal Airways, Suction Equipment, and Oxygen Therapy);

- Impedance Threshold Devices (ResQPOD);
- Active Compression/Decompression CPR (CardioPump);
- Supraglottic Airways in Resuscitation (i-gel Airways);
- Cardiac Defibrillation (AEDs);
- Emergency Action and Road Accidents;
- Acute Illness;
- Burns and Extremes of Temperature;
- Bleeding, Wounds and Eye Injuries;
- Bites, Stings and Poisoning;
- Bone, Joint, Chest, Pelvic and Abdominal Injuries;
- Childbirth;
- Remote Area Emergency Care;
- Drug Administration under Medical Direction;
- Pain Management: Inhaled Analgesia (Entonox/ Methoxyflurane);
- Advanced Bleeding Management;
- Advanced Fracture Management;
- Spinal Stabilisation and Immobilisation;
- Moving and Lifting Patients;
- Assessments;
- SMART Triage Assessments (**OPTIONAL**).

Dress Code: Work attire as per company policy.

Re-certification: The RTO recommends that the below units be renewed every three years:

- HLTAID003 Provide first aid;
- HLTAID005 Provide first aid in remote situations;
- HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid;
- PUAEME005A Provide pain management;
- EMRPHC410 Implement the universal triage system for pre-hospital care.

The units; HLTAID007 Provide advanced resuscitation and EMRPHC412 Utilise intrathoracic pressure regulation technology within emergency medical care, are to be renewed every 12 months, as per the Australian Resuscitation Council Guidelines.
