
COURSE ELEMENTS

Theory

- Legislation;
- Confined space entry;
- Hazard analysis and risk management;
- Permit systems;
- Fire awareness;
- Atmosphere testing;
- Ventilation testing;
- Resuscitation;
- Compressed air breathing apparatus;
- Safety equipment;
- Rescue.

Practical

- Implementation and operation of confined space entry permit system;
- Calibrating and using gas detection equipment;
- Use of confined space entry/rescue equipment;

- Confined space entry;
- Basic confined space rescue scenarios;
- Confined space work positioning techniques.

ASSESSMENT METHODS

If a candidate gets a total score of less than 100% then the trainer will explore the learners' knowledge of the topic. Where the candidate has a good knowledge of the topic the result may be amended.

Practical assessment requires the learners set up and sign entry permits, correctly use gas detection equipment prior and during entry.

Learners must perform confined space entries including work positioning techniques, as well as participation in a confined space rescue.

During the course of the training learners will be continually verbally assessed by the trainer to ensure they have the required understanding and competency required on specific topics and scenarios.
